



### System benefits

Colour plays an important part in sign recognition. Did you know that 8% of all males yet only 0.4% of females are colour blind? The first colours to go are green and red. **Aculog** uses clear symbols and the written word on its status holders and cards so that there is no confusion as to the status of the scaffold, its purpose or the safe working load it has been built for.

#### **Status Holder**

Decent size, very visual, available in 3 colours. Colours assist in separating Project / Maintenance work or scaffold companies. Manufactured from quality UV stabilized polypropylene.

#### **Inspection / Register Card**

**Check list** itemized to ensure consistency between scaffold inspectors. Records details of scaffold size, scaffolders, location and client.

**Equipment** totals recorded – assists in stock control, hireage and recovery.

Labour tracks man hours to build / dismantle scaffold

Blue card - Tube and Coupler

Green card - System scaffold

Yellow card - Alloy Mobile

**Green Scaffold Safe Card** 

**Safe Working Load** maximum loading on scaffold. Person or Company whom requested the scaffold. Purpose / task the scaffold was built for. Job number or code for control.

Date and Time inspection carried out.


**Comments** record alterations made or any damage to scaffold.

**Signature** of the Scaffold Inspector.

## How the system works

Status Holders displaying "Scaffold Unsafe" are hung at scaffold access points during the scaffold construction



The complete scaffold is inspected using the relevant Aculog **INSPECTION/REGISTER CARD** and signed off by the scaffolder inspector.




The Green SCAFFOLD SAFE card is also completed, signed off and placed in the status holder

he complete scaffold

The complete scaffold is inspected using the relevant Aculog INSPECTION/REGISTER CARD and signed off by the scaffolder inspector.



The Green SCAFFOLD SAFE card is also completed, signed off and placed in the status holder

If the scaffold is found to be:

- (a) Unsuitable for its purpose
- (b) faulty
- (c) incident related

The Green
SCAFFOLD
SAFE card is to be REMOVED
IMMEDIATELY and the scaffold
Supervisor notified.



# Aculog INSPECTION/REGISTER checks must be carried out:

- In accordance with statutory / site regulations
- After each structural alteration or addition
- After any storm or occurrence that could adversly affect the safety of the scaffold

Aculog INSPECTION/REGISTER
CARDS are retained in the Acufile Wall
Holder at the site office.


Prior to dismantling scaffold, remove the green Scaffold Safe Card ensuring the **SCAFFOLD UNSAFE STATUS** throughout this operation.



Aculog INSPECTION/REGISTER cards can be retained as a record of inspections, equipment and labour
